# **TSA Flight Training Security Program (FTSP)**

# Citizenship

#### You must:

- Verify citizenship of anyone requesting flight training
  - o Flight training does not include periodic, recurrent training required by the FARs such as
    - Flight reviews
    - Instrument proficiency checks
- Document the verification by either
  - o Keeping a copy of the document proving citizenship for 5 years, or
  - o Making the following logbook entry in the student and your logbooks:

"I certify that [insert student's full name] has presented to me a [insert type of document presented, such as U.S. birth certificate or U.S. passport, and the relevant control or sequential number on the document, if any] establishing that [he or she] is a U.S. citizen or national in accordance with 49 CFR 1552.3(h). [Insert date and instructor's signature and CFI number.]"

If the person is a US citizen, you may begin training immediately.

### Training in Light Aircraft that Requires TSA Approval

Aliens who desire training leading to:

- Any first FAA certificate
- Any first FAA instrument rating
- Any first FAA multiengine rating

# To Provide Training to Aliens

#### You must:

- Register with TSA to provide training
  - o https://fts.tsa.dhs.gov/home
- Verify the person is going to train with you
- Validate the person's application data
- Wait for TSA's "Permission to initiate training"
- Take a photo of the student on the first day of flight training and submit it to the TSA

### **Security Awareness Training**

### You must receive:

- Initial TSA Security Awareness Training
  - Within 60 days of being hired
- Recurrent yearly training
  - o Within on calendar month before and after the month you completed initial training
